DAY 1 ARRIVE BOSTON - CAPE COD

Today, we will arrive in Boston at Logan International Airport where our local tour escort will meet us to begin our tour of the "Cape" and the islands of Nantucket and Martha's Vineyard. Enroute to the Cape, we will pass cranberry bogs and adorable 18th-century homes with salt-spray roses tumbling over trellises and gates. We'll check-in to our hotel, (our home for the next four nights), and have time to unpack or enjoy a swim in the pool. Later, we will join our new-found friends for a wonderful welcome dinner. (D)

DAY 2 CAPE COD - PROVINCETOWN

This morning, we will depart for a full day of touring and enjoying the beauty of the Cape. Visit The National Seashore Park and the Salt Pond Visitor's Center in Eastham enroute to Provincetown (otherwise known as "P-Town"). Pass quaint cottages ringed by rambling red roses and see miles and miles of beautiful beaches and windswept dunes. No wonder many say that this is the one of the most scenic parts of the Cape. We will arrive in Provincetown, a resort and artist colony filled with shops and galleries. Here, we will cap the day off with a delicious Lobster Bake dinner with all the fixin's. Return to the hotel after this exciting day. (D)

DAY 3 MARTHA'S VINEYARD

Savor a hearty breakfast this morning before boarding the ferry for Martha's Vineyard. Known as "the Storybook Island", Martha's Vineyard was settled in the 1600's by missionaries and later by whalers. The largest island off the New England coast has much to offer -- windswept moors, dense forests, dramatic coastal cliffs, soft sandy beaches and six delightful towns -- with not a single traffic light or a McDonald's. We will be met at the dock in Oak Bluffs by a local bus and guide and then taken on a tour of the island. See the steep cliffs of Gay Head, the colorful gingerbread cottages of Oak Bluffs, Menemsha's fishing shanties and the sea captains' mansions in Edgartown. Enjoy lunch on our own and some free time for shopping in Edgartown. Later this afternoon, we will board the ferry back to the mainland and have the rest of the evening at leisure. (B)

DAY 4 NEWPORT MANSIONS

Today, we will board our coach and travel to Newport, the yachting capital of the East and one of New England's most delightful coastal towns. For over a century, Newport has been the favored vacation spot of affluent socialites. Here, we will tour The Breakers, once the seaside summer "cottage" of Cornelius Vanderbilt II. This is perhaps the most palatial of all the estates of Newport. Next, it's on to Rosecliff where "The Great Gatsby" was filmed. Fashioned after Marie Antoinette's Grand Trianon at Versailles, Rosecliff boasts a beautiful garden with sculptures by St. Gaudens. Afterwards, we will delight in an included lunch and have time for shopping at the Brick Market place. We will return to our "Cape" hotel and have the rest of the evening free. (L)

DAY 5 NANTUCKET

After a filling breakfast, we will depart the hotel with our luggage and board the ferry for Nantucket, known as the "Far Away Isle". Here, surrounded by the waters of the Atlantic, is nestled a community whose original Colonial New England heritage and atmosphere of 300 years ago is virtually unchanged. It's a treasure chest full of history, art, architecture and legends reflecting the long-past but never-forgotten whaling era. We will be met upon arrival and taken on a sight-seeing tour of this picturesque island. Later, we will check-in to our hotel and prepare for a scrumptious finale dinner with our travel partners. Afterwards, the evening is free to stroll the cobblestone streets or attend a local event. (D)

DAY 6 DEPART FOR HOME

A farewell breakfast is included this morning before we ferry back to the mainland. Our coach will be waiting for us as we transfer to Boston's Logan Airport. Relax as we return home filled with memories of the quaint harbors, the legendary islands, the rose-lined country roads and the sweet smell of sea air! (B)
