Day 1 - Tuesday, September 12, 2017


Depart from from your hometown using own transportation. Have lunch (on own) enroute. Travel to Valdesta, GA for lodging at the Drury Inn. Have dinner (included) this evening. [D]



Day 2 - Wednesday, September 13, 2017

Have breakfast (included) at the hotel. Travel to Ft. Meyer and take time for lunch (on own) at the Ft. Meyer Downtown River District. There are several restaurants and dozens of shops to explore. Check into the Best Western Fort Myers Waterfront Hotel. It is a three-diamond property overlooking the Caloosahatchee River. There is a sundeck along the water, a heated

outdoor pool, an elevator and an on-site seafood restaurant. Tonight board the Seminole Gulf Railway for a Mystery Dinner Train. Use your detective skills to unravel a comical mystery that will unfold before your eyes. The train leaves the Colonial Station and travels a freight rail line serving Southwest Florida. Dinner (included) is served as you take the 40-mile round trip journey. [B,D]





Day 3 - Thursday, September 14, 2017

Have breakfast (included) at the hotel and leave for Sanibel Island. Take a 90-minute tram tour of the J.N. Ding Darling National Wildlife Refuge. It is located on the subtropical barrier island of Sanibel in the Gulf of Mexico. The refuge is part of the largest undeveloped mangrove ecosystem in the U.S. It is world famous for the spectacular migratory bird population. Have lunch (included) before visiting the Bailey-Matthews Shell Museum. Enjoy the display of shells from around the world with a focus on Southwest Florida. Enjoy a relaxing two hour ride through rural communities to the take an air boat tour. Feel the wind in your face as you skim the surface of the water to see unique wildlife and vegetation. The captain will present interesting history, folklore and fun facts about the plants and animals in the area. [B,L]



Day 4 - Friday, September 15, 2017

Have breakfast (included) at the hotel. Tour the Edison & Ford Winter Estates, winter homes for inventor Thomas Edison and automobile industrialist Henry Ford. The three-acre winter home of Ford, nicknamed Mangoes, features a display of Ford vehicles dating to 1914. Edison's 14-acre riverfront estate includes a laboratory and experimental gardens. Guest can explore the nine historic buildings, the 1929 historic landscape and the 15,000 square foot Museum filled with hundreds of inventions and artifacts, special exhibit galleries and documentaries about the famous inventors. Catch lunch (on own) at the Café or at the full-service restaurant next door. Leave the estate and stop at the Sun Harvest Citrus retail store. You can watch the workers in the packing area as you select your favorite citrus fruit. Conclude our time in Florida with dinner (included) in elegant comfort and cruise these beautiful coastal waters. [B,D]



Day 5 - Saturday, September 16, 2017

Have breakfast (included) at the hotel. Travel to Richmond Hill, GA and check into the Holiday Inn Express. Transfer to downtown Savannah to shop at Paula Deen's and have dinner (included) at her world famous Restaurant, The Lady & Sons. [B,D]

Have breakfast (included) at the hotel. Enjoy the beautiful scenery of South Carolina and Tennessee. Have lunch (included) and return Home by late afternoon. [B,L]
