
Your Group Name Presents: Savannah and Charleston September - October 2017

Day One

Group arrival at the Charleston where you will be greeted by your local escort and deluxe motorcoach. Travel through the South Carolina Low Country towards Savannah and the Rose Hill Manor Plantation. A guided tour of the home will include period furniture, low country history and the vital role of the house and its owners. A light dinner of sandwiches, salads, desserts and teas are included at the plantation. We check into our hotel where we spend the next three evenings. Enjoy your room and a good night's sleep. (D)



Day Two

Breakfast this morning is included at the hotel. This morning enjoy a tour of Savannah's historic district which will include historic architecture, lush botanicals, and wonderful stories that make this coastal city an unforgettable place. Lunch and shopping on your own on historic River Street. Your afternoon is free to explore the historic district on your own. This evening we enjoy a fabulous dinner at Darin Seifert's Kitchen Table for a cooking class featuring a Low Country Menu. Return to the hotel for a good night's sleep. (B,D)

Day Three

After breakfast, we board the coach for a day of touring. This morning we take a boat tour of the Savannah Low Country through the inland waterways. Visit the Tybee Island Lighthouse along the journey. Lunch on your own at Papa's BBQ. Enjoy a visit to a historic home or museum this afternoon. Dinner this evening is served at the Pirate's House followed by an evening of entertainment at the Savannah Theater. (B,D)

Day Four

Following breakfast we board the coach for our journey to historic Charleston, SC. Based on availability you will visit Parris Island. During 1715 an Englishman named Colonel Alexander Parris purchased the island and eight small surrounding Islands. Until the Civil War, plantation life flourished here. Today 18,000 Marines are trained here and is the home of the 4th Recruit Training Battalion and is the only battalion in the Corp to train female recruits. You will tour the base with a stop at the Museum. (You will need everyone's Name, address social security number to be admitted onto the base two weeks prior to arrival.) Lunch on your own in historic Beaufort overlooking the bay. Board a small bus to tour Beaufort, South Carolina, located in the heart of the Carolina Lowcountry midway between Charleston and Savannah, harbors a rich repository of 18th and 19the century houses With marked Architectural variety. Enjoy a close look at our homes And architecture, church yards and plant life. We continue to Charleston, SC where we will stay for the next two evenings. Dinner this evening is served at the popular Noisy Oyster Restaurant. Return to the hotel for a night's rest. (B,D)



Day Five

After breakfast, we board the coach for a day of touring. This morning we enjoy a guided tour of historic Charleston. Tour through the High Battery, see historic homes, visit Patriot's Point and Fort Sumter. Enjoy free time to explore the City Market area. This afternoon tour the Charleston Tea Plantation, America's ONLY tea garden is pleased to offer you an experience that is not only educational but more importantly one-of-a-kind. Located on picturesque Wadmalaw Island in the heart of the Lowcountry, the Charleston Tea Plantation is home to American Classic Tea. Come experience the beauty and charm...View acres and acres of breathtaking tea plants as far as the eye can see, learn first-hand how tea is made during an informative Factory Tour, take an enjoyable Trolley Ride through the tea fields and help yourself to all of the iced American Classic Tea you can drink. Factory Tour: The Bigelow's themselves, via flat screen televisions; guide you down a glass tourway overlooking the factory. You will learn about the history of tea, the harvesting and production of our own American Classic Tea, and the story of the Charleston Tea Plantation. Trolley Tour: Enjoy a scenic ride around our 127 acre farm. The Tour is narrated by William Barclay Hall, our founder and world renowned Tea Taster. He will educate you about the history of America's ONLY tea garden while challenging you and your knowledge of tea. This evening dinner is served at the Charleston Crab House before returning to the hotel. (B, D)



Day Six

Breakfast is served at the hotel. Today we visit the Boone Hall Plantation. Enjoy a ride up the Avenue of the Oaks to the historic home and plantation. A guided tour of the home and grounds is included. Lunch is served at the RB's Seafood Restaurant. Conclude our visit with a trip to the Magnolia Plantation. Founded in 1676 by the Drayton family, Magnolia Plantation has survived the centuries and witnessed the history of our nation unfold before it from the American Revolution through the Civil War and beyond. It is the oldest public tourist site in the Lowcountry, and the oldest public gardens in America, opening its doors to visitors in 1870 to view the thousands of beautiful flowers and plants in its famous gardens. Board a tram to tour the Audubon Swamp Garden. It is a unique world where trees grow from the water, islands float, and everywhere wild creatures go about their secret lives. It boasts a diversity of living things almost unequaled anywhere else in America. Thousands of plant and animal species coexist amongst the cypress and tupelo gum trees, surrounded by blackwater. Each year, hundreds of egrets, herons, and other waterfowl nest within feet of the walking path. You can explore this wild and otherwise inaccessible landscape on boardwalks, bridges, and dikes. Travel to the airport for your flight home.
