Day One

Also included is Jacques Cartier Square and McGill University. The afternoon is at your leisure to explore the city on your own. Dinner is included this evening at another of Montreal's fine restaurants. (B,D)



Day Three

After a full breakfast, travel north to Cote-de-Beaupre, home of the Ste.-Anne-de-Beaupre – the most important Roman Catholic Shrine in Canada. Through the decades, pilgrims from all over the world have gone here to see relief from suffering. Time is available to stroll the grounds or to visit the inspirational Cyclorama (Optional) which depicts the life of Christ. The next stop is Montmorency Falls, one of the most impressive in North America. We will also visit Marie's Bread Oven, where everyone can sample a delicious slice of warm bread with maple butter or a visit to a local copper museum. Arrive in charming Quebec City, where we check into our hotel for the next two evenings. This afternoon we enjoy a guided tour of the Chateau Frontenac and conclude with tea and pastries. This evening dine in the restaurant of your choice and enjoy live Quebecois folk music in a pub on Rue St-Jean! (B)



Day Four

Our day begins with a full breakfast before departing on a sight-seeing tour of Quebec City. Visit both the Old and New Quebec. Our tour includes a Parliament, St. Louis Arch and ends at the Place Royale, the site of the original settlement of the city of Quebec. This afternoon is free to shop or browse through the city's cobblestone streets. Tonight, join our new found friends for a delicious dinner at a typical French restaurant. (B,D)
