This year's 2017 festival marks the 106th celebration of the original gift of 3,000 cherry trees by the city of Tokyo to the people of Washington, DC in 1912. DAY 1 ARRIVE D.C. - NAT'L AIR & SPACE MUSEUM

After dinner, stop at the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts before returning to the hotel. (B,L,D)

DAY 3 CHERRY BLOSSOM PARADE - SMITHSONIAN MUSEUMS

Have breakfast before departing for our reserved seating at the National Cherry Blossom Festival. The celebration includes a massive parade, which navigates down historic Constitution Avenue. After the parade, walk to the National Mall and visit your choice of the Smithsonian Museums (often called America's attic). It is among the worlds greatest museums and is composed of several museums each devoted to a particular interest or study. Enjoy lunch on our own in one of the museums cafeterias while visiting. A delicious dinner is included this evening at a very nice downtown restaurant. Afterwards, depart on a Illuminated Tour of the Air Force Memorial built on the hillside over looking the Pentagon and later visit one of the most moving memorials ever constructed, the Pentagon 9/11 Memorial Park . (B,D)

DAY 4 ARLINGTON NAT'L CEMETERY - NEWSEUM - WWII MEMORIAL

After breakfast, depart for Arlington National Cemetery via the Tourmobile. See rows of white gravestones that never seem to end. View the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the John F. Kennedy Eternal Flame. Not faraway is the grave of Robert E. Kennedy, marked with just a simple cross. Stop at the Marine Corps War Memorial (Iwo Jima Staue). Arrive at Union Station for lunch on our own. Continue with a visit of the spectacular Newseum. (The Museum of News). Make a memorable and moving stop at the new National World War II Memorial. We will also stop at The Vietnams Vterans Memorial, The Lincoln Memorial and The Korean War Veterans Memorial. Return to the hotel for the rest of the evening. Enjoy free time and dinner on your own this evening. (B)

DAY 5 MEMORIALS - LUNCHEON CRUISE - DEPART FOR HOME

Breakfast at our hotel this morning prior to checking out. We stop for a photo opportunity at the Whitehouse. Then visit the Franklin D. Roosevelt Memorial and The Jefferson Memorial located on the Tidal Basin. Next join our newfound friends for a lovely lunch onboard the Odyssey III Cruise Ship, Washington's Premier Luncheon Cruise!
