Day One

Group arrival at Logan International Airport in Boston. Today you will be greeted by your local guide and deluxe motorcoach before enjoying some free time in Boston. We check into the Holiday Inn Dedham where we spend the next four evenings. Dinner is included at our hotel this evening. (D)



Day Two

After breakfast, you are joined by your local guide for a journey to the home of the Elite 400, Newport. We meet our local step on guide at the Visitor Center before taking a journey around Ten Mile Drive where you will see the Summer Cottages of the Astor's, Vanderbilt's and other famous wealthy American's. Next we enjoy a traditional Rhode Island lunch featuring local seafood at the Pier Restaurant. This afternoon enjoy a guided tour of one of the beautiful mansions which may include the Breakers. Day Three

Following breakfast, begin a full day of touring the historic area of Lexington and Concord. Stand on the Lexington Green, where the farmers, alerted to "The British Are Coming", took a stand against British oppression. Travel along the Battle Road to Concord and stop at the Old North Bridge. Lunch is served in Boston at the famous Cheer's Pub. Afterwards, follow the Freedom Trail, enjoy a photo stop at the

USS Constitution. Visit the Old North Church, the Boston Common and Public Garden. Tonight, enjoy some free time in the North End, the oldest Italian Neighborhood in America where you can enjoy dinner on your own in one of the many fabulous restaurants. (B,L)



Day Four

Today we journey to Maine's southern coast. Our first stop takes us to the village of Ogunquit where we board the Finest Kind Lobster Boat for a lobster pulling cruise. Next we travel to the town of Kennebunkport where you can enjoy lunch and shopping on your own. This afternoon we travel past Walker's Point, Summer Home of Former President Bush, visit the Nubble Lighthouse, visit Stonewall Kitchens. This house was considered a mansion in its time and you can still see the treasures on display as well as experience a secret that this house holds.
