Day One - Monday, October 7, 2024

Our next stop is at Sugarbush Farm, where you will learn about the art of maple sugaring. We'll return to the hotel for another delicious dinner. (B,D)





Day Three - Wednesday, October 9, 2024

This morning after breakfast we will make our way north to Burlington, VT. Here you will have the opportunity to explore the shops that make up the Church Street Marketplace. We then board the Spirit of Ethan Allen for a scenic cruise and buffet luncheon on the waters of Lake Champlain. Following lunch we make our way South to Weybridge, VT. We will pay a visit to the University of Vermont Morgan Horse Farm, designated as a National Historic Site. See these beautiful high stepping horses in action and learn about America's first breed. Next up is a stop at the Danforth Pewter Factory. Marvel at the wide variety of handcrafted pewter and perhaps you'll have an opportunity to watch a spinning demonstration. Day Four - Thursday, October 10, 2024

Following breakfast we make our way to Montpelier, the capital of Vermont (the smallest city to serve as capital of a U.S. state). We will take a guided tour of the recently restored Vermont State House and hear its fascinating history. Our next stop brings us to the Cold Hollow Cider Mill, one of the top producers of apple cider in all of New England. Watch the cider press in action and tempt your senses with the delicious tastes and smells of their wide variety of apple products. We then travel to Stowe, VT and the Trapp Family Lodge (built by the Von Trapp family of "Sound of Music" fame. We'll indulge in their delicious buffet lunch packed with Bavarian specialties. Following lunch we take a brief tour through the halls filled with memorabilia. Hopefully you saved a little room for dessert because our next stop is at Ben & Jerry's Ice Cream Factory.
