Day 1 (D)

Transfer to the airport for your flight to New Orleans. Upon arrival you'll be greeted by your tour guide and enjoy a **City Tour of New Orleans**. Then settle into your hotel for a 2 night stay. Once checked in, enjoy dinner in the **French Quarter**. Enjoy the rest of the evening exploring the French Quarter on your own.

Day 2 (B, L)

Morning at leisure with opportunities to visit the WWI Museum or the Mardi Gras Museum.(on own transportation included) Later travel back in time today as we tour Manors and Mansion from the Deep South beginning with **Houmas House & Gardens**. Enjoy **lunch at Café Burnside** nestled among the beautiful gardens. Afterwards, tour this location which is considered the *Crown Jewel of Louisiana's River Road*. Next travel to the **Laura Plantation**, a Creole plantation known as a top tourist attraction in Louisiana. Travel back to the hotel for some R & R or explore more of the French Quarter. Dinner on your own. Consider visiting Café Du Mon for one of their famous beignets for dessert.

Day 3 (B, L, D)

Today experience Cajun country as we depart our hotel and travel towards Lafayette, LA. **Dine at Poche's Cajun Café** before we explore the bayou on **Champagne's Cajun Swamp Tour**. After we finish our travels to Lafayette and settle into our hotel for a 2 night stay, we are in for some down home fun at **Martin's Cajun Accordion Experience** (one of only 2 establishments left in the world). Finish our day **dining at a local restaurant** (TBD) with your fellow travelers.

Day 4 (B)

This morning we are off to visit **Vermillionville**. Get a taste of life for the 18th-century Acadian settlers in this 23-acre village with meticulously recreated period homes, costumed staff demonstrating arts and crafts and a restaurant serving Cajun and Creole food. Next, we will have a spicy good time as we tour the **Tabasco Plant and** shop at their **Country Store**. Our evening is on leisure in Baton Rouge.

Day 5 (B)

As we depart the hotel, we make our last stop for a visit at **The Capitol Park Museum**. With thematic exhibits on diverse aspects of Louisiana history, industry and culture, the museum includes two permanent exhibits: Grounds for Greatness: Louisiana and the Nation and Experiencing Louisiana: Discovering the Soul of America.
